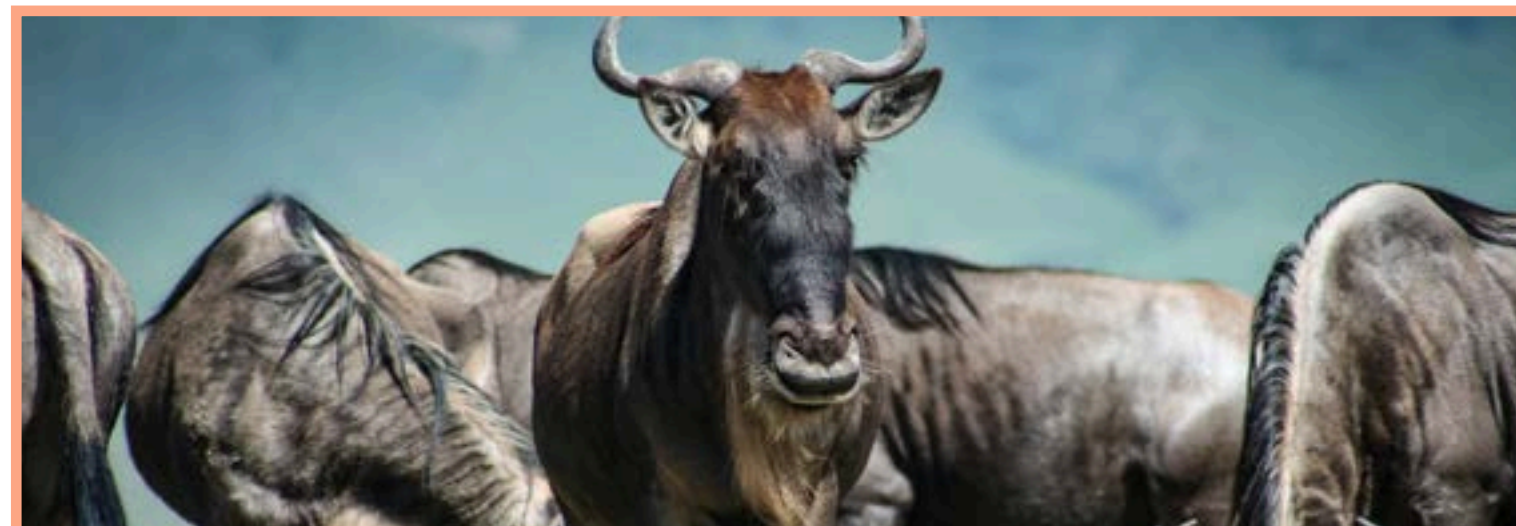

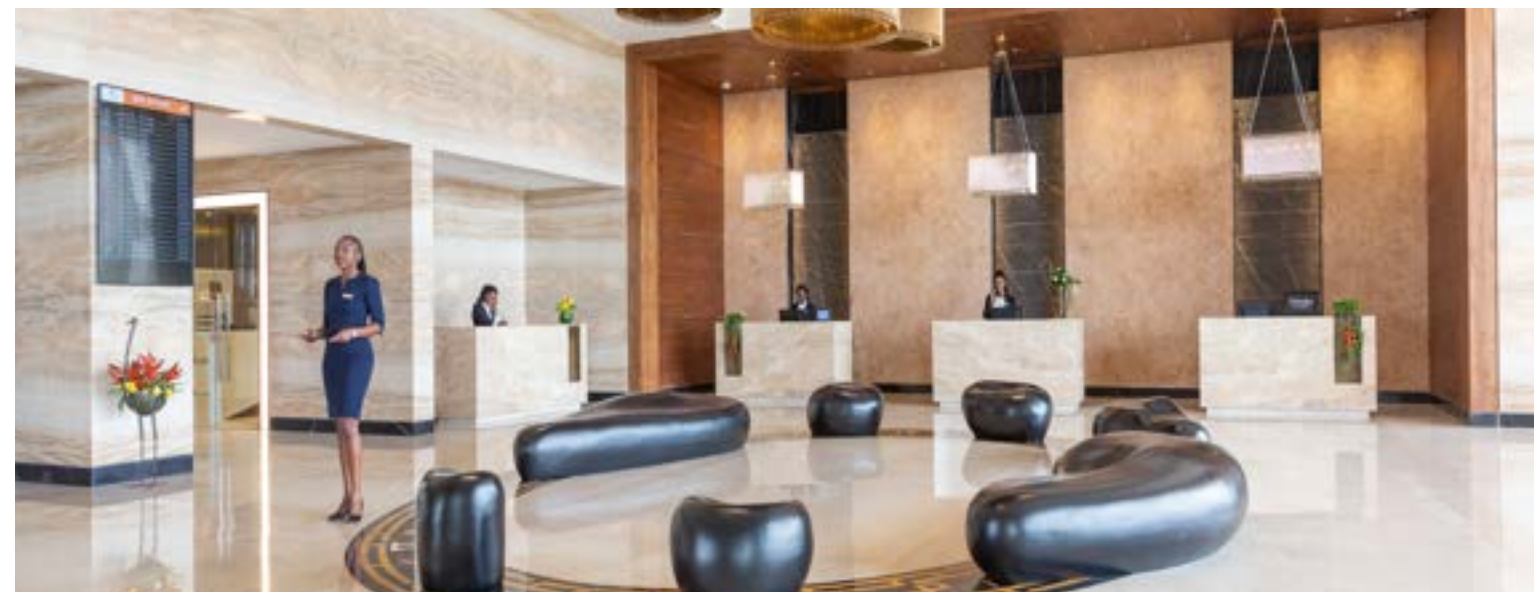

CARNIVORE RESTAURANT



Guests will be taken to Carnivore Restaurant with a scenic drive enroute. At the restaurant, meats are roasted on traditional Maasai swords over a huge charcoal pit that overlooks the restaurant's entrance. The rough-hewn beams combine the rustic feel of a rural setting with that of a benighted banqueting hall. First, the soup of the day along with a plate of home baked brown bread and butter are served. Then, an army of carvers move table to table, swords laden carving juicy cuts onto scorching cast-iron plates. Accompanying the meat feast is a selection of salads, vegetable side dishes and sauces. The feeding expedition doesn't stop until you declare defeat by lowering the white paper flag perched on top of the central tray. This is then followed by dessert and coffee. The full meal including the soup course is at a set price. Vegetarian menus are also available on request. Guests will later be transferred to their various pick up points.

DAPHNE SHELDRIK ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE



After breakfast, guests get the opportunity to visit Daphne Sheldrick elephant orphanage via the city's leafy suburbs. Here, you will get the chance to have exclusive interactions with orphaned elephants and learn more about them and how they found themselves at the orphanage. The experience at the orphanage is truly magical as you get to stand really close to the largest mammal in the world. Guests will then be dropped off at their respective hotels.



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GIRAFFE CENTRE

The Giraffe Centre was started to protect the Rothschild giraffe from extinction due to loss of habitat. The centre has been effective in the protection of the animal since the Rothschild giraffe is densely populated today along the East African grasslands. Guests have the opportunity to feed giraffes from a uniquelyelevated platform using your hand or even your mouth. The giraffes come to the platform with their tongues out in anticipation of the food clients are given to feed them. Guests will later have lunch and then drop off at their various pick up locations.

KAREN BLIXEN MUSEUM



The Karen Blixen Museum was once the centre piece of a farm at the foot of the Ngong Hills owned by Danish Author Karen and her Swedish Husband, Baron Bror Blixen-Finecke. Located 10km from the city centre, the museum belongs to a different time period in the history of Kenya, and later gained international acclaim with the release of the movie ‘Out of Africa’, an Oscar winning flm based on Karen’s autobiography by the same title. The museum also offers a nice place for personal reflection on the nature trail. Guests can later have lunch then be dropped off at their respective pick up points.

KAZURI BEADS FACTORY



After breakfast, guests will visit Kazuri Beads Factory in Nairobi where unique ornaments and jewellery are crafted. Kazuri began in 1975 as a tiny workshop experimenting on making handmade beads. It started with two Kenyan women and soon discovered that there were many other women in the villages around Nairobi,most of whom were single mothers, and were mostly unemployed. Driven by the desire to provide such opportunities, Kazuri has grown and today has a large work force skilled in the making of handmade jewellery that are quite remarkable such as necklaces, bracelets and even pottery. Guests will later have lunch then laterbe dropped off at their respective pick up locations.

KIAMBETHU TEA FARM



The farm is just a short drive from the heart of Nairobi. Kiambethu Farm provides an ideal insight into life on a settler farm. Situated at 7,200 ft., Kiambethu was bought and farmed by AB McDonell in 1910. He was a pioneer in the tea industry being one of the frst to make and sell tea commercially in Kenya -now one of Kenya’s largest exports. Five generations have lived on the farm and it is currently run by his granddaughter Fiona Vernon. The farm house is set within beautiful gardens surrounded by acres of tea and indigenous forest also home to the black and white Colobus monkey. Guests can also purchase high quality tea from the farm. Lunch will be enjoyed at the farm then guests are dropped off at their respective pick up locations.

KITENGELA GLASS



Guests will depart from the hotel and head to Kitengela Beads Factory. Kitengela Hot Glass recycles and transforms scrap material into objects & designs that have a future, address a need or fulfil a function or desire. The process of recycling scrap glass is improved by melting it & hardening the objects made using old engine oil as a fuel, which burn about 200 litres of used oil per day. The factory makes items such as drinking glass, furniture and even various sculptures from glass. These items are available for purchase by the guest. Visitors will then have lunch then be dropped off at their respective pick up locations.

LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK.



Guests will leave their respective hotel early and head to Lake Nakuru National Park. Here they will have a game drive inside the park. The park is rich in flora and fauna with a huge number of bird species such as the African fish eagle and animals such as lions, leopards and rhinos. The park also provides spectacular viewing points for Lake Nakuru itself and the aquatic birds such as flamingoes present on the lake. Lunch will be relished inside the park. Guests will later be transferred to their various pick up locations.

NAIROBI NATIONAL MUSEUM & SNAKE PARK



Guests leave immediately after breakfast for Nairobi National Museum and Snake Park which are adjacent to each other with a scenic drive enroute. Guests will get the chance to learn more about the history of the country as well as interact with live bird and mammal species that are preserved in the cradle of mankind gallery. It was founded by Ms. Julie Church who encouraged mothers to collect, wash and cut the disregarded slippers into colourful products to sell at local Kenyan markets as another means of income for their families. The income realized by Ocean Sole used to pay bonuses to all employees, invest in a welfare program that allows employees to facilitate payments for educating their children or even purchase of land. The flip flops are turned into beautiful sculptures that are available for purchase by the guest. Guests will also have lunch then be dropped off at their respective pick up locations.

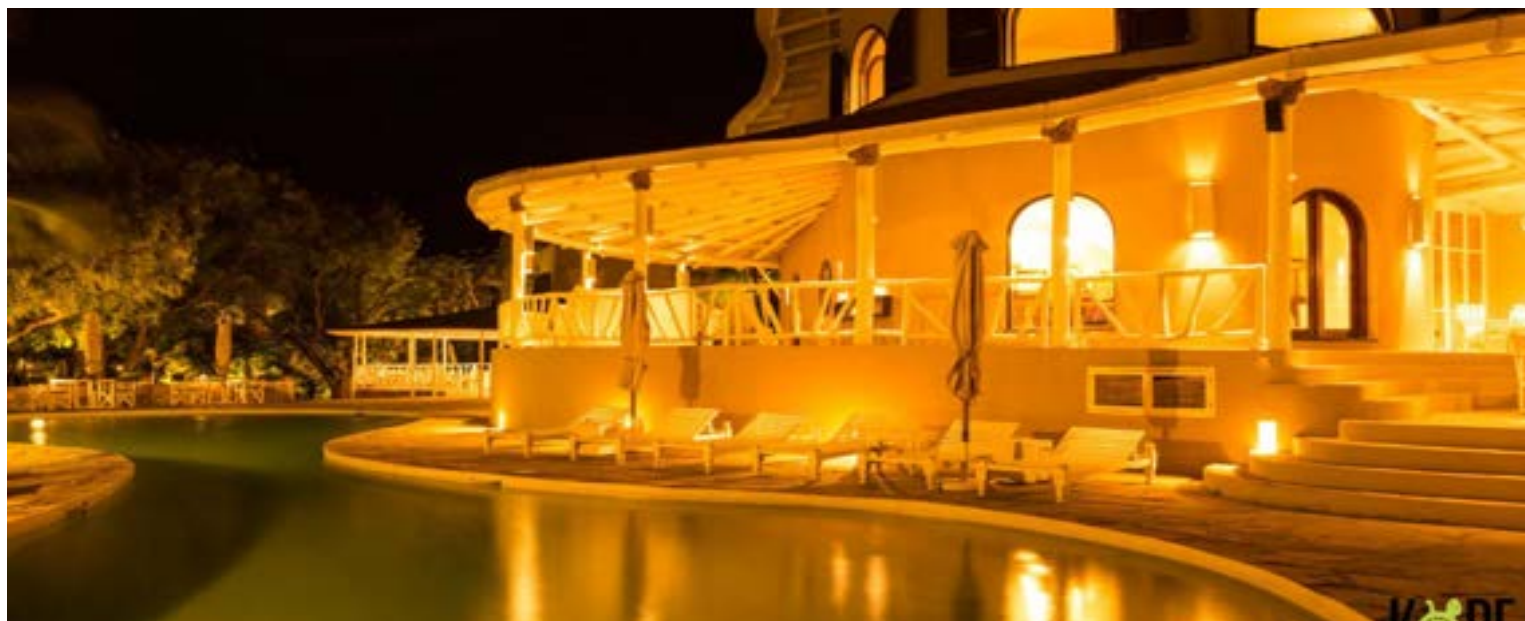

It is set on white sand Garoda Beach along the Indian Ocean, the resort is 24 km from the Malindi Airport and 1 km from Local Ocean Trust, a turtle preservation and protection centre. The hotel has 1 bedroom suites that offer flat-screens, safes, and minifridges, plus hot beverage making facilities. All include relaxing spaces and terraces with sitting areas. Upgraded suites have traditionally thatched roofs and 4-poster beds with mosquito nets. A private area on the beach offers umbrella-shaded sun recliners. There are also 2 outdoor pools, an open-air bar/restaurant, and spa treatments, as well as tropical gardens where guests can relax and free their minds.

MSAMBWENI BEACH HOUSE



Msambweni Beach House has a main house and 3 villas. It is located in Msambweni, a small traditional fishing town located in Kwale County, just a 30 minute drive from Ukunda Airstrip. 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COAST EXCURSIONS



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FORT JESUS AND OLD TOWN



After breakfast, guests will head out towards Fort Jesus Historical Site. The Fort was built by the Portuguese in 1593-1596 to firmly protect the old port of the city of Mombasa. The fort is one of the most outstanding and well preserved models of Portuguese military prowess and a landmark in the history of such a type of construction. Fort Jesus bears physical evidence, in its structures and consequent transformations, also to the exchange of cultural values and influences between and among peoples of African, Arabs, Turkish, Persian and European origin that fought to gain and maintain their control over this unique port. Across the fort, guests will have the chance to crisscross the narrow streets and also appreciate the ancient architecture of the Mombasa Old Town. You will pass by the old post office and also see the old port of Mombasa that the Portuguese vowed to protect. Guests will later have lunch and be dropped off at their specific hotel/resort.

MWALUGANJE ELEPHANT SANCTUARY



Guests will head out towards Shimba Hills for Mwaluganje Elephant Sanctuary. The sanctuary is a conservation area for elephants that was introduced to act as a wildlife corridor to facilitate movement of elephants between Mwaluganje Forest Reserve to the north and Shimba Hills National Reserve to the south. Elephants use this migratory passageway to access important foliage areas within their natural domain at different times of the year. The sanctuary supports threatened lowland coastal forest that contains rich diversity of flora and fauna including several rare and endemic species such as the sable antelope. It serves as one of only 3 coastal shelters for elephants in Kenya and is also an important water catchment area for wildlife and the local communities. Guests will later have lunch and be transferred to their specific hotels/resorts.

SCUBA DIVING IN DIANI



Guests have an option to go for scuba diving in the deep blue waters of the Indian Ocean. The coral reefs around Diani offer a humongous variety of marine life from the beautiful macro creatures to the giant whale shark and manta ray. Diani Beach has also been continuously rated one of the top destinations in the world for diving activities. The scuba diving activities are conducted by highly trained professionals who have vast experience in the diving field. Clients are also required to go for training for a day then obtain a PADI before he/she can be taken for the activity. Guests will later be dropped off at their various hotel/resort.

SHIMBA HILLS NATIONAL RESERVE



Guests will leave very early for Shimba Hills National Reserve and arrive just in time for a morning game drive. Apart from being one of the largest coastal forests in East Africa after Arabuko-Sokoke Forest, this reserve is rich in flora and fauna and is home to the highest density of African elephant in Kenya. Other animal species found in the area are the rare sable antelope which is exclusively found in the reserve, elephant shrew, giraffes and other mammals like fruit bats and vervet monkeys. Shimba Hills National Reserve is also home to the breath-taking Sheldrick Falls. You will be escorted by an armed ranger towards the falls through a 2.5km rocky hike. Swimming at the falls is allowed for a limited amount of time. Guests will later have lunch and be dropped off at their respective hotel/resort.

SKY DIVING IN DIANI



Guests get then once in a lifetime opportunity to get a bird's eye view over Kenya's most beautiful beach, Diani. This activity allows you to experience the ecstasy of free fall and a splendid canopy flight over the coastline without any extensive training. The skydiving activity is carried out by highly trained professionals who ensure your utmost safety before and after the diving exercise. It entails a safety briefing from the instructors, a 20 minute scenic flight above the beach, a 40 second free fall and a 5 minute parachute descent with a gentle beach landing. Guests will later have lunch and be dropped off at their various hotel/resort.



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SNORKELLING IN DIANI



Guests depart immediately after breakfast aboard a traditional dhow. Leave the coast behind as the dhow carves through the crystal-clear lagoon before snorkeling over colourful reefs as shoals of tiny fish swim across. One of the most popular spots is Kisite Mpunguti Marine National Park, where rocky coral formations hide dazzling marine life. Enjoy the temperate waters as an incredible scene plays out below; bizarre lionfish on the hunt, sea turtles effortlessly gliding past the reefs and numerous dolphins playing across the deep blue sea. Later have lunch and be transferred back to the hotel/resort.

TSAVO EAST NATIONAL PARK



Guests will depart the hotel before dawn to allow them have a glimpse of the African sunrise and spend the day at Tsavo East National Park. The park is approximately 3 hours from Mombasa town through Voi gate. This excursion allows you to take a break from the busy Coastal beaches and discover a wilder side of the Kenyan wilderness. The park is home to the 'red' elephants and the famous 'Mudanda Rock' where wildlife can be observed from a cliff top as they drink water from the waterhole below. The park also has a diverse wildlife and bird species including lions, giraffes, buffaloes, silver backed jackals and hornbills. Lunch will be enjoyed inside the park before later heading back to your respective hotel/resort.

WASINI ISLAND TOUR



Guests will take a dhow ride across the Indian Ocean towards Wasini Island. The island is a unique refuge full of peace and tranquility and is miles away from the hustle and bustle of Kenya's coastal beaches. Off the south coast of Wasini lies the beautiful Kisite Mpunguti Marine National Reserve which is a dhow/boat ride away. On boat tours within Wasini Island, visitors can spot turtles, marine tortoise, coral reefs and different types of colourful marine fishes as well as three notable species of marine mammals; bottlenose dolphin, humpback dolphin and the humpback whale who thrive in the warmer sea waters. Many seabirds in large nesting colonies as well as migratory birds in substantial numbers can also be found such as crab-plovers and roseate terns. Guests will be taken to one of the local villages and enjoy traditional Swahili seafood for lunch. They will be later be dropped off at their various hotel/resort.



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KENYAN PARKS

BORANA CONSERVANCY

Borana is located at the foot of Mt Kenya north of the equator, settled on the Laikipia Plateau. The conservancy was started to protect the black and white rhinos from extinction due to increased poaching in the 1970s. In addition to rhino, other threatened and endangered species such as African bush elephant, lion, reticulated giraffe, cheetah, African wild dog, Jackson's hartebeest and Grevy's zebra are also protected inside the conservancy. Mount Kenya poses a beautiful backdrop for the conservancy, with views of the mountains snow-capped peaks to the south, and a landscape of mountains and desert to the North. The conservancy works with local communities and other partners to maintain a sustainable ecosystem for tourists to holiday and wildlife to thrive in. Borana and Lewa conservancies removed the fence separating them and formed the largest black rhino sanctuary in Kenya. The conservancy also has high end lodges to enable guests relax and unwind after a busy day in the wild. It is accessible by air through flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

CHYULU HILLS NATIONAL PARK

Chyulu Hills is a rugged wilderness with evidence of its volcanic origins and boasting the most exclusive and breathtaking views of Mt Kilimanjaro. It is a craggy clutter of ancient volcanic cones and craters, as well as the longest lava tube in the world. The park is placed between Tsavo West National Park and Amboseli National Park and boasts outstanding and diverse landscapes. The wildlife in Chyulu Hills include cheetahs, antelopes, black rhino, zebra, giant elands, wildebeests, steenbok, bush bucks, bush pig, elephants and lions. Lake Jipe lies in the south-west corner of the park and is a haven for birdwatchers with bird species such as the knob billed geese, pied kingfisher, white backed night heron, black heron palm-nut vulture and African skimmer. The park has luxurious accommodation facilities such as Oldonyo Lodge where guests can relax and chill after a full day in the wild.

LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Lake Nakuru National Park is a premium game park in Kenya, one of only three in the country and is currently one of the most visited game parks in the country. It has beautiful scenery with attractions such as Lake Nakuru which best identifies the park and the Great Valley escarpment. The park is a bird lover's paradise because of the over 400 bird species including the flamingos, African Fish Eagle, Slender-billed greenbul, Long-tailed widowbird, Rufous-throated wryneck, Montane white-eye, Red-capped lark, Northern puff back, Rüppell's robin-chat, Shining sunbird that reside in the park. The park is also a wild game destination for animal lovers and wildlife explorers. It is habitat to over 100 endangered black and white rhinos; home to the endangered Rothschild's giraffe and other 50 or more animal species that include buffalos, waterbucks, lions among others. To protect the rhinos from poachers, the Kenyan government erected a 188km² electric fence around Lake Nakuru National Park in 1986. The park has luxury lodges and tented camps where guests can chill and relax before and after a long day on safari.

LEWA WILDLIFE CONSERVANCY

Lewa Wildlife Conservancy occupies about 65,000 acres of untouched African wilderness. The conservancy has dramatic views of snow-capped Mt Kenya to the south, and the arid lands of Tassia and Il Ngwesi to the north. Lewa displays a variety of wild habitats from highland forests, wide open grasslands, melt-water mountain springs and acacia woodland that supports over 450 recorded bird species. Lewa conservancy is well-known for its successful rhino and Grevy zebra breeding, two critically endangered species making it home to 10% of Kenya's rhino, and 20% of the world's Grevy zebra population. The conservancy does widespread outreach work into the surrounding communities with its Community Development Program including healthcare, education, micro-finance, and water projects. The conservancy is also home to the Ngare Ndare Forest that is part of the wildlife corridor that links Lewa to other parks and conservancies in the North. Lewa Conservancy guests have unconstrained access to an incredibly stunning landscape that supports a diversity of animals including antelope, giraffes, elephants, buffalos and other herbivores that upkeeps striking cheetahs, stealthy leopards, mighty lions, brutal wild dogs and other predators. Both the 'big five' and 'special five' are found here. High end lodges are found in the conservancy where guests can unwind and freshen up after a tiresome day in the wild. It is accessible by air through scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

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LUMO COMMUNITY WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Lumo Community Wildlife Sanctuary is a community owned wildlife sanctuary in Kenya, located near Mwatate in Taita-Taveta County near the Coast, approximately 220km from Mombasa. It covers an area of 48,000 acres. Lumo Community Wildlife Sanctuary is adjacent to Tsavo West National Park and the Taita Hills Wildlife Sanctuary. It hosts lots of wildlife including the Cape buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, Maasai giraffe, common zebra, hartebeest, impala, waterbuck, Thomson's gazelle, lesser kudu, dik-dik, and other smaller animals, including a great variety of birdlife. The conservancy is a vital migration corridor between Tsavo East and West, and a link to Taita Ranches and Mkomazi Game Reserve in Tanzania. The sanctuary has one community-owned tourist lodge, the Lion's Bluff Lodge. The land is mainly rolling savannah and breathtaking views from Lion's Bluff Lodge stretch all the way to Pare mountains in Tanzania as well Africa's highest mountain, Mt Kilimanjaro. The neighbouring Taita Community also benefits from the conservancy through bursaries, health care, improvement of infrastructure and education. It is accessible by air through Lion's Bluff private airstrip.

MAASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Masai Mara National Reserve is located in south west Kenya and is a massive eye-catching expanse of gently rolling African savannah plains measuring 1510 km² in area and bordering the Serengeti National Park in Tanzania to the south. Masai Mara is a unique wildlife conservation hub, well-known for its remarkable natural diversity of wildlife and is an ideal Kenyan safari location in East Africa, giving guests several reasons to visit this animal kingdom. The park is divided into two main areas; the inner portion which features unspoiled wilderness and the outer portion which allows for cattle of the Masai community to graze. The reserve also has community conservancies bordering it which enhances conservation and protection of wildlife. Popular wildlife that can be seen in the Mara include hippo, giraffe, waterbuck, reedbuck, roan antelope, warthog, eland, topi antelope, gazelle, zebra, baboon, crocodile, various species of monkeys, and black rhino. Predator species found in the Mara include lion, leopard, cheetah, jackal, hyena, and various mongoose species. The reserve has the largest population of lions in the entire country. It is also home to the marvel that is the wildebeest migration experienced between July and October. The migration involves millions of wildebeests and zebras crossing the crocodile infested Mara River into the Mara from Serengeti in Tanzania. They are also tracked by the big cats before and after they cross making the migration truly action packed and impossible to forget. Lodges and luxury tented camps make your accommodation inside the Mara top notch and can provide extra activities such as bush meals & sundowners to make the experience even merrier. Balloon safaris provide the guests with a 1 hour glide over the Mara plains with mind blowing aerial views of wildlife with bush breakfast served upon landing. Cultural visits to the local Maasai villages and schools enhance cultural education and you can learn the Maasai way of life.

MARA NABOISHO CONSERVANCY

Mara Naboisho conservancy is more than 52,000 acres consisting of land contributions from 636 landowners. Naboisho is home to the big cats in striking numbers and large herds of elephant, giraffe, and wildebeest. The population of lions within Naboisho Conservancy is one of the highest in the world, with a population of more than 70 identified lions who have resident habitats inside the conservancy. Rare species such as Aardvark, Caracal, Serval cat, Aardwolf, and Ratel are occasionally found. Nocturnal species such as predators who hunt at night can be seen since Naboisho allows resident guests to experience night game drives. Naboisho is a bird watcher's paradise with several bird species rarely seen elsewhere in the Mara such as White-Headed Buffalo-Weavers, Northern White-Crowned Shrike, Pigmy Falcon, Hornbills and Bush Pipits. The conservancy strictly monitors the number of tourists who enter the area, reducing the number of vehicles and the human impact on the environment and wildlife.



OL DERKESI CONSERVANCY

The Olderkesi Conservancy lies on a crucially important pathway to the greater ecosystem and comprises a variety of habitats including grasslands, riverine valleys, forests, and woodlands. It's a haven for many species of wildlife and a route for the great wildebeest migration. The conservancy is situated between Masai Mara National Reserve and Loita Hills along the southeastern border of the reserve. It also is home to one of the most elegant safari camps in the wild, Cottar's 1920s Safari Camp and is also managed by Cottar's Wildlife Trust that promotes conservation of wildlife for sustainable development. The trust has been able to agree with the local community to withdraw from grazing their cattle inside the conservancy and instead give them monthly payments to reduce human wildlife conflict. The conservancy is exclusive to resident guests who are allowed to have day and night game drives among other activities. It is accessible by air from Nairobi through daily scheduled flights departing from Wilson Airport.

SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE

Samburu National Reserve is located in Northern Kenya and is a premier game reserve placed on the banks of the Ewaso Ng'iro River. The reserve is a unique wildlife conservation stronghold famous for an abundance of rare species, "the Special Five" such as the Grevy Zebra, Somali Ostrich, Reticulated Giraffe, Gerenuk and the Beisa Oryx that are exclusively found in the Northern part of the country. The reserve is also home to a population of over 870 elephants and large predators such as the lion, leopard and cheetah. Wild dog sightings are also common to this unique protected area as well as abundance of bird species with over 450 recorded species. The reserve has lodges and luxury tented camps for guests to unwind and relax as they await their next safari. It is also accessible by air through daily scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

MARA NORTH CONSERVANCY

The Mara North Conservancy (MNC) is a breathtaking wilderness area of approximately 69,160 acres. It is the largest conservancy and an integral part of the Maasai Mara ecosystem as it forms the north-western zone that borders the Maasai Mara National Reserve. The aim of the conservancy is to create a best practice, outstanding conservancy with long-term conservation of the environment, wildlife and members of the local community. The Conservancy is a partnership between fourteen member camps and 700 landowners. Mara North Conservancy is one of the most populated wildlife areas within the Maasai Mara ecosystem. It is home to the Leopard Gorge which is a vital birthing and maternity ground for the big cats such as lions and leopards. The conservancy is also home to the eye-catching Lemek Hills, an important sanctuary for the extremely threatened African wild dogs. The park is accessible by air with daily scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

TSAVO WEST NATIONAL PARK

Tsavo West is part of the larger Tsavo ecosystem that is divided into two and is more popular than Tsavo East. Its popularity is based on the man eating lions that killed hundreds of people during the construction of the Kenya -Uganda railway and the highway during the colonial period. It is the second largest national park in Kenya with an area of 9,065km². It's separated from Tsavo East by the highway that links Nairobi to Mombasa. It is more scenic than Tsavo East with rugged mountainous areas. The park is also home to over fifty million gallons of crystal clear water that comes from under parched lava rock and is called Mzima Springs. The Shetani lava flow is a dark layer that was left after volcanic eruptions happened in the park many years ago and is a unique attraction to the park. The park is covered by the open savannah grassland dotted with acacia woodlands, scrublands, rocky ridges and riverine vegetation making it highly scenic and eye catching. It is home to Africa's big five which include: Lions, Elephants, Buffalo, Rhinos and Leopards. Other wildlife found in the park are: giraffes, zebras, hyenas, cheetahs, hippos, crocodiles, gerenuk, lesser kudu, waterbucks, wildebeests and others. The park also has an abundance of birdlife including the rare corncrake, basra reed warbler, secretary bird and the noisy hornbills. Lodges and luxurious tented camps are present in the park for the guest to relax after a long day safari. It is accessible by air through daily scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

MERU NATIONAL PARK

Meru National Park is located in Central Kenya about 350 km northeast of Nairobi and sits to the northeast of Mount Kenya. The park serves visitors with an array of nature encounters including jungle, grasslands, swamps, rivers, and landscape with an abundance of termite created mini hills. The national park receives a substantial amount of rainfall allowing for the growth of tall grasses and the development of rich swamps making it a wildlife haven. Wildlife is diverse and plentiful with common species such as the elephant, giraffe, black rhino, white rhino, kudu, gazelle, hartebeest, reedbuck, zebra, and hippo. Predator species include lion, leopard, cheetah, jackal, African wild cat, and the spotted hyena. The park is also a bird watcher's haven with over 430 bird species recorded in the park such as superb sterling, pygmie falcon, crested eagle, martial eagle, Kori bastard and many others. The park is also the location where the famous George and Joy Adamson raised the lioness named Elsa and shared the story via the book and movie both named "Born Free." It also has a rhino sanctuary with up to 60 rhinoceros protected in the sanctuary. The camp is also home to Elsa's Kopje Lodge where guests can relax and unwind after a tiresome day on safari. It is accessible by air through daily scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK

Nairobi National Park is the first park to be gazetted in Kenya on December 16th 1946. The park is located about 7km south of Nairobi, and is the only wildlife park in the world that is located in the capital city. The park is made up of thick woods near the city outskirts, partly rolling plains and valleys, and partly wooded confluence of several rivers and its vegetation is the dry savanna type. Nairobi National park is the major rhino sanctuary for breeding and restocking other parks and is home to over 100 mammal species having four of the Big five (lion, Buffalo, leopard, rhino). Other animal species in the park include the zebra, black rhinoceroses, giraffe, various antelope species as well as numerous reptiles such as the terrapin. The park has over 500 recorded bird species with at least being seasonal European migrants and they include the Secretary bird, lesser kestrel, Martial eagle, Pallid harrier, Sooty falcon, White-bellied bustard, Grey crowned crane, Corncrake and many more. The park is approximately 30 minutes from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and has a luxury lodge, The Emakoko, where guests can unwind after a long trip or day in the wild.

OL PEJETA CONSERVANCY

OI Pejeta Wildlife Conservancy is a 364km² wildlife paradise located between the foothills of Mt Kenya and the Aberdare ranges. It is truly a wildlife paradise since over 10000 species of mammals are found inside the conservancy. The conservancy also has the fastest growing black rhino population and is also where the last two remaining Northern white rhinos in the world; Najin and Fatu are protected. OI Pejeta is also the only wildlife hub where chimpanzees can be seen in the chimpanzee sanctuary that is home to 5 chimps. Guests have the opportunity to adopt a chimpanzee and give it a name. Both the 'big five' and 'special five' are found inside the conservancy. During game drives you might spot lions scanning the plains, giraffe and elephant munching on whistling acacia thorn trees, cheetah scheming for prey or even the rare wild dog and leopard. OI Pejeta is home to 'Baraka' the blind rhino who is kept and fed on his own space. Baraka is mostly used for educational or research purposes and also offers an upclose encounter with a rhino. The conservancy also has luxurious lodges and tented camps where guests can relax and unwind after a long day in the wilderness. It is accessible by air through scheduled flights departing Nairobi from Wilson Airport.

Guests can also relax at the lodge and enjoy the amenities including an infinity swimming pool, recreational spa and a state of the Art Wine Cellar. Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1: Arrive at Kigali International Airport

Welcome to the Land of A thousand Hills. Upon arrival at Kigali International Airport, you will be welcomed by one of our experienced safari guides who will transfer you to your Hotel for the rest of the day and overnight. At check in, you will be briefed about your safari and what to expect.

Overnight at your Hotel, Kigali Serena Hotel booked on Bed and Breakfast basis.

Day 2: Kigali City tour and transfer to Akagera National Park

Morning breakfast at your Hotel in Kigali and set out for a half day Kigali city tour. The tour is inclusive of a visit to the Kigali Genocide Memorial Site and Museum, Nyamata genocide Church, local markets and so on. Later have Lunch and then depart for Akagera National Park. Evening game drive. Overnight at your Lodge, Ruzizi Tented Camp booked on Full Board basis. Magashi Camp supplement is available for luxury

Day 3: Full day in Akagera (Game drive and boat ride)

Morning breakfast and set out for a game drive in the park. Akagera National Park is a well- known Savannah Park and is located in north eastern side of the country's boarder with Tanzania. This small park is a home to several big mammals which cannot be found anywhere else in Rwanda. Have your cameras ready and eyes open as you search for the big game animals such as the Elephants, Zebras, Giraffes, Buffaloes, Water bucks, Bush bucks and the recently introduced Lions. The game drives with in the park normally are carried out in northern sector and these can last for hrs. depending on the day's animal sightings.Return to your Lodge for Lunch and in the afternoon, set out for the boat ride on Lake Ihema in search for Hippos and Crocodiles as well as other game animals on the river banks. Dinner and overnight at your Lodge, Ruzizi Tented Camp booked on Full Board basis.experience upon request.

Day 4: Akagera NP to Volcanoes National Park.

Breakfast at your camp and check out, you will drive to Volcanoes National Park which is a home to the endangered Mountain Gorillas, other primates' species like the Golden Monkeys as well as a lot of bird species. The Park is located in northern Rwanda in Kinigi, Musanze which is about 2 hours' drive from Kigali the country's capital. Your drive from Akagera National Park to Volcanoes will be via Kigali city and will offer you with scenic views of the different villages with great landscape. Arrive in the evening at your Lodge for dinner and leisure.

Overnight stay at Five Volcanoes Lodge booked on full board basis

Day 5: Gorilla trekking in Rwanda and Community Walk

Today morning after breakfast, you will be transferred from your lodge to the park headquarters for the days' briefing about Gorilla trekking activity. It's advisable to park your lunch, drinking water and hire porters as the time taken in the jungle is unpredictable. After the briefing from the park rangers, you will be allocated your Gorilla family and then head into the forest to search for the gentle jungle giants. Tracking the Gorillas may take a few hrs. to a full day to hike up and down the mountain as this always depend on where they were last seen the previous night. Physical Fitness is highly recommended but also those who are not fit enough, they have the chance to hire Human helicopters (Sedan chair). Upon seeing the gorillas, you will be allowed to stay with them for one hour maximum (Take videos and Photographs). Then later return back to your Lodge for lunch. Afternoon at leisure with a community walk to red rock a local initiative that improves community livelihood through Environmental Conservation, Arts & Culture, Education, and Community Health & Security.

Overnight at your Lodge, Five Volcanoes booked on full board basis.

Day 6: Transfer to Nyungwe Forest National Park!

Morning breakfast at your lodge and check out, commence your 6 -7 hours' drive to Nyungwe Forest National Park, one of the oldest and largest rain forests in East Africa, the forest is popular for this rich biodiversity including a small population of chimpanzees as well as 12 other species of primate, including the Lhotse's monkey endemic to the Albertine Rift. Overnight at Nyungwe Top view Hotel booked on full board basis

Day 7: Chimpanzee Tracking and Canopy Walk.

Early morning set out for the famous Chimpanzee trekking in Nyungwe forest National Park. The activity will take you deep into this jungle forest to search for the Man's closest friend in the world of primates the chimpanzees. Normally you are advised to park your breakfast from the Lodge as the briefing starts as early as 5:30am and then start on your experience by 6:00 am. You will be briefed about how to behave as well as the Park's dos and don'ts.Your ranger guide will lead you to either the Uwinka trail head or The Cyamudongo sector for the start of the chimp trekking experience. The Park is well endowed with rich biodiversity and is a home to more than 13 species of Primates including the Chimpanzees, LHoest's monkeys, Rwenzori Colobus monkeys, red tailed monkeys, vervet monkeys, grey cheeked mangabeys and so on. Lunch at the Lodge and afternoon set out for the famous Canopy walk experience where you will be exploring Nyungwe National Park at 40 meters high above the ground level.Dinner at your Lodge.

Overnight at Nyungwe Top view Hotel booked on full board basis.

Day 8: Nyungwe to Kigali – Departure;

Enjoy your breakfast at leisure before embarking on your 4 to 5 hours journey back to Kigali. On the way you will have a stopover at Huye which was formerly known as Butare. This is the city which hosts the ethnographic museum of Rwanda which was formerly known as the National Museum of Rwanda. You will learn more about the country's culture and their history plus the normal day to day lives of the Rwandan people. Proceed with your journey to Kigali and arrive in the afternoon connect to your international flight.
